

MARYLAND 4-H PRESENTS! PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The participant must be enrolled in the County 4-H Program and age 8 by January 1 of current year. This means a signed enrollment form on file in the County Extension Office by June 1 of current year.
2. Participants may only give one presentation. Categories are:
 - Demonstration – Food/Nutrition (Food may not be offered to judges or the public.)
 - Visual Presentation (Any 4-H project other than food/nutrition.)
 - Prepared Speech
 - Radio Public Service Announcement
 - Interpretation
 - Talent
3. **Presentation Length** – Presentations will be given once and must be at least 3 minutes in length, but not exceed 15 minutes. (Exception: Radio PSA and talent presentations may be less than 3 minutes.)
4. **Equipment:** Microphone, easel, and table will be provided. Participants must provide all other supplies and equipment needed for the presentation.
5. **Judging:** Content (introduction, general information and summary of main points) and Presenter (appearance, delivery, visual aids, and time).
6. **Awards:** Participants will receive a ribbon and a premium based on their rating (Excellent, Very Good, Good).
