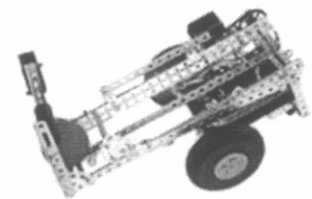
Next Meeting: June 12, 2006 at 7 pm
