

Frederick Master Gardener Training Class Scholarships

- (1) Why do you want to take the training?
- (2) What will you contribute to the Master Gardener program?
- (3) Why do you need a scholarship?

Please submit these paragraphs along with the rest of your application, no later than January 5th (this date may change, so please double-check directly with the Master Gardener Coordinator at 301-600-1596). The scholarship application will go separately to a scholarship committee for review. The scholarship committee will determine scholarship recipients based on the essays submitted. Because the focus of the program is volunteer service and public education, the committee is seeking applicants especially interested in public outreach and community project involvement.
