6. **Imported Cabbage White:** Adult and Larva



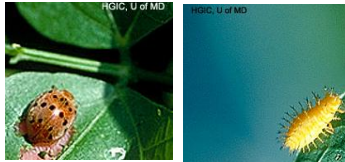
7. **Garden Caterpillars:** Hornworm, Cutworm, Earworm, European Corn Borer

9. **Mexican Bean Beetle**



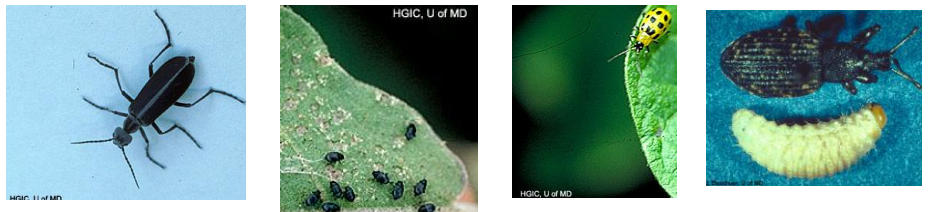
10. **Bugs:** Squash, Harlequin and Green Stink

14. **Grasshoppers**



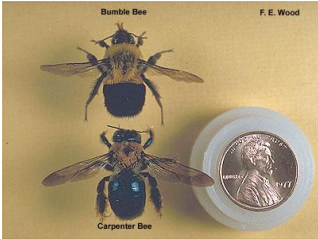

18. Yellowjackets and Other Wasps-Paper, Scoliid: Pest for sting, otherwise wasps are considered beneficials!



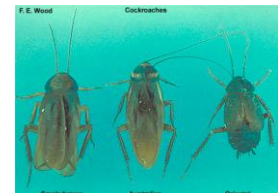

22. Cereal Pests: **Indian Meal Moth**, **Saw-toothed Grain Beetle**, **Rice Weevil**
