3. All tractors will be provided.
4. Driver must be seated at all times, must keep feet on pedals at all times, and must back up.

3. Ages 8 and 9
4. Powder Puff - Women over 21



SECTION 2 - PRE-4-H INDOOR EXHIBITORS - OPEN AND 4-H

...For little ones not old enough to join 4-H, but old enough to enjoy it. Enter projects the kids have been working on. Anyone under 8 years of age eligible. You can choose to enter Pre 4-H Division or Open Indoor Division, not both.

1. A \$2.00 premium will be awarded to all pre-4-H entries. Special Pre-4-H participation ribbons will be awarded.
2. Use 4-H entry tags from the Extension Office or registration table on Tuesday, July 14 or Wednesday, July 15.
3. Only one entry for each Indoor Department, please. As an example, only 1 Food Preparation, or 1 Craft, or 1 Vegetable.
4. Enter as many different departments as you'd like. No entries accepted in outdoor classes.
5. All entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 15, and may not be removed until Sunday, July 19, 8:00 a.m.



SECTION 3 - BABY CONTEST

Saturday, July 18, 6:00 p.m.

There is a \$2.00 registration fee per child.



SECTION 4: OPEN LAWN MOWER PULL

Chairperson: David Blyman Co-Chairperson: Brett Bigelow
Thursday, July 16 - Registration 6:00 p.m., Contest 7:00 p.m.

1. Tractors must be operated in a safe manner at all times.
2. Operators must remain seated during pull and must have complete control of the tractor at all times.
3. No consumption of alcoholic beverages in the track or pit area before or during the pull. Alcoholic beverages not permitted on Fairgrounds.
4. Each participant can have two attempts to pull sled.
5. The first tractor in each class has the option for a second pull. If second pull is chosen, this participant pulls in the third position and must take this footage.
6. No rain covers on stack.
7. Tractors must remain within the track boundaries.
8. Any loss of weights or equipment parts during the pull will result in a disqualification.
9. All tractors must have strong and rigid seats.
10. Shut off switch must be within reach of the participant.
11. Any hole digging or jerking of the sled will result in disqualification.
12. Contest is open to garden tractors with rubber tires. No 4-wheel drive, dual tires, tire studs or chains permitted.
13. Draw bar may be no longer than ten inches from the center of the rear wheel to the point of hook-up.
14. Draw bar must be stationary in all directions and no higher than the center of the axle.
15. All stock tractors must be equipped hood.

Causes for Disqualification

1. Use of illegal fuels.
2. Unsafe operation of competition vehicle.
3. Intoxication of participant.
4. Illegal equipment (see above rules).
5. Leaving starting line under red flag.
6. Unsportsmanshiplike conduct.
7. Loss of weights.
8. Hole digging.
9. Jerking of the sled.
10. Driving off track.
