1. See animal rules and regulations on page 6.
2. This is not a sanctioned American Dairy Goat Association show.
3. Dairy goats may be registered or recorded grades.
4. Base age for all goats shall be determined by the day of the show.
5. The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older. The original registration certificate or duplicate application stamped by ADGA office is required for all animals under six months of age. These must be shown to the Show Secretary before the start of the show. No copies of the registration certificate or the stamped duplicate application, telegrams or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate. Goats in the in the "Maryland 4-H Dairy Goat Leasing" Program must be assigned to the youth by May 1 of the current year. The individual must comply with the rules stated in the Maryland 4-H Dairy Goat Leasing agreement and have agreement papers ready for inspection at show.
6. Goats with abscesses in any stage will not be allowed to unload.
7. Open animals must be in place and checked in by 12:00 p.m. on Thursday. Open and Milking Goats will be released upon conclusion of the show. Show will begin at 1:00 p.m. with Showmanship classes. 4-H animals must be in place by 8:30 a.m. Thursday. **NO** animals will be released before 8:00 a.m. on Sunday.
8. Open Division can enter up until day of show with double entry fees of \$10 per animal. Pre-Enter by June 15 for \$5 per animal fee.
9. There will be no pre-show milkout.
10. All animals are entered at owner's risk.
11. No horned animals allowed. Show Committee has the right to disqualify an exhibit for infringement of rules. Animals shown in group/ special classes must have been shown in their regular class.
12. There is no pen fee; however, a limited number of pens are available.
13. Only Kent 4-H'ers may enter 4-H division.
