1. All participants must follow all General and Health Rules and Regulations.
2. There will be no entry required for the Herdsman Contest. All 4-H'ers entering dairy, goat, livestock, or horse exhibits that will stay on the fairgrounds, will automatically be judged in the Herdsman contest.
3. Indicate on entry form whether you will be judged as a group or an individual.
4. The winner will be announced at the awards program Sunday at 12:00 Noon.
5. Herdsman entries will be scored as follows:

P O I N T S	20	Educational Value of Exhibit (Exhibitor name and information present and clearly visible; Educational information about animal species present; Information clear and understandable; Information of value or interesting to the public)
	20	Animal Care (Animal is clean and comfortable; Animal has water/feed available as appropriate for each species - Check with Herdsman Chair for specifics of each species; animal looks healthy and cared for)
	20	Cleanliness (Exhibit area clean and neat; Area including aisles are free from trash; stray tools and equipment and other debris)
	20	Attractiveness (Exhibit area is colorful and attractive to the public; Exhibit has an interesting "theme" or subject matter; Effort was displayed in preparing and organizing exhibit)
	<u>20</u>	Cooperation (Exhibitor show positive attitude; Exhibitor show cooperation and willingness to work with other 4-H'ers; Exhibitor works well with adults, volunteers, parents and fair staff)
