1. Each participant must submit a typed or very neatly handwritten narration to the 4-H Office **by July 1**. The story will be read by the Master of Ceremonies during the presentation. Include your name and phone number.
2. Any animal that can be controlled by exhibitor and costumed may enter. Only animals that are being shown at the Fair in their respective species classes are eligible for the Pretty Animal Contest, except in open class.
3. All General and Health Rules and Regulations must be followed.
4. Awards will be presented in each class to the outstanding entries in each of the following categories:
 1. The Prettiest
 2. The Funniest
 3. The Most Creative (Except for Class 5 & 6)
5. Judging will be based on the costumed animal and the narration.
6. You may not enter more than 1 animal per class.
7. Open class exhibits must have appropriate health papers for species. Open class animals do not have to show in their respective breed class.

Classes:

1. Junior (8-13) SMALL ANIMALS (rabbits, dogs, poultry, sheep, small pets, goats, etc.)
2. Senior (14-18) SMALL ANIMALS
3. Junior (8-13) LARGE ANIMALS (beef, dairy, horses)
4. Senior (14-18) LARGE ANIMALS
5. Junior Dairy Promotion (DAIRY ANIMALS ONLY)
6. Senior Dairy Promotion (DAIRY ANIMALS ONLY)
7. Open - Any age exhibitor, animal any species.
