WHAT IS IT? 4-H Dog Fun Day is an event for ALL 4-Hers, whether they have dogs or not! You do not have to be enrolled in the 4-H Dog Project or plan to train or show a dog to attend. 4-Hers are welcome to bring their dogs, but dogs are not required to attend.

WHO CAN ATTEND? 4-H Dog Fun Day is open to **ANY** enrolled 4-Her in the 5 Southern Maryland counties (Anne Arundel, Calvert, Charles, Prince George's, St. Mary's). Registration is **FREE!** You do not have to be enrolled in the Dog project to attend.

WILL THERE BE FOOD/DRINKS? No food or drinks will be available on site. Participants should bring a picnic lunch to enjoy during the "lunch and learn" part of the program. Don't forget to bring a snack and water for your dog!

WHAT WILL 4-HERS DO AT DOG FUN DAY? 4-Hers will learn about different activities they can do with their dogs, to teach them new skills or "just for fun." Professional dog trainers and handlers will give workshops on basic skills, then 4-Hers will get to try them out with their dogs! Workshops will include:

- 🐾 Basic Rally Obedience
- 🐾 Basic Agility Obstacles (jumps, tunnels, weave poles)
- 🐾 AKC Canine Good Citizen
- 🐾 AKC Trick Dog
- 🐾 4-H Dog Project Opportunities

I WANT TO BRING MY DOG! WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW? Friendly, well-behaved dogs are welcome to attend Dog Fun Day with their 4-Her. The following rules will be observed:

- 🐾 Dog must belong to the 4-Her's family or be leased to the 4-Her according to Maryland 4-H Animal Science Leasing Program requirements. *Contact your county 4-H Office if you have questions about leasing a dog.*
- 🐾 A parent, guardian, or designated responsible adult must remain on-site for the duration of the Dog Fun Day.
- 🐾 Dog must have a current Rabies vaccination, proof of which must be provided at check-in. Additional current vaccinations (distemper, parvo virus, lyme disease, etc) are strongly encouraged. Dog must be healthy and sound. No female dogs in season will be allowed to participate.
- 🐾 Dog must be leash broken and the 4-Her must be able to positively control the dog without assistance of a parent or other person. 4-Hers will handle their dogs without assistance during workshop activities. Dogs will remain on leash and/or under control at all times, including during workshop activities and the talent show.
- 🐾 Any dog showing signs of aggression toward other dogs or people will be dismissed from the event. The responsible adult will be required to immediately remove the dog from the fairgrounds.
- 🐾 Dog must be registered for the event along with the 4-H member, in 4-H Online (See below).

HOW DO I REGISTER? All 4-Hers and dogs must register for this event via 4-H Online. When registering in 4-H Online, the date of current rabies vaccination must be entered for each dog, and a liability release must be electronically signed by the 4-Her's parent/guardian. Registrations must be completed by 11:59 pm on **Thursday, June 14, 2018.** There is no fee for this event (ignore the payment screens).
