Carroll County 4-H Reopening Update

I'm excited to announce that we will be able to open 4-H programming on April 1st! Of course we are following all of the Maryland 4-H guidelines and we will have to limit group sizes to 25 or less individuals for indoor and outdoor events at this time. I will be working with our club leaders and volunteer led programs to work through all of the procedures of approval processes for meetings/events. Before attending any in-person event, please be on the lookout for information with specific guidelines that will need to be followed including: social distancing, wearing a mask, and signed health pledges just to name a few. Please read through the Tribune carefully as you will find that many of our spring activities are taking place in-person, but we are requiring registration to ensure we stay within our group size limits.

Even with 4-H programming opening for some activities on April 1st, at this time, Extension Office faculty remain on a telework status. Email is the best way to get ahold of any of us. 4-H Enrollment

ALL 4-H Members, Clovers and UME Volunteers will need to enroll for the 2021 4-H year by logging into 4-H Online (v2.4honline.com) to complete your 2021 enrollment. Please note that EVERYONE (4-H MEMBERS, CLOVERS AND UME VOLUNTEERS) will need to log into their family account that you created in 2020 and re-enroll each person listed on your account. **DO NOT** CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT – LOG IN USING YOUR EMAIL AND PASSWORD. If you have forgotten your password, there is an option to restore your password.

ALL 4-H MEMBERS including CLOVERS MUST PAY THEIR \$10 PARTICIPATION FEE THROUGH 4-H ONLINE. The insurance fee for 4-H Members, Clovers and UME Volunteers is paid through your 4-H Club and will not be collected at this time.

Remember you must be enrolled into the Carroll County 4-H Program by May 1, 2021 to be eligible to show at the 2021 Carroll County 4-H/FFA Fair. Please don't wait to enroll, enroll now!

UME Volunteers

ALL UME Volunteers MUST be enrolled in 4-H Online (v2.4honline.com) by March 1, 2021. This new deadline is a Maryland 4-H requirement to meet the new background check requirements. Even if you missed the March 1st deadline, we will still work with getting you enrolled! When completing the volunteer enrollment, remember this is a two-step process. Step 1 is the enrollment which leads into step 2, the screening process.

Please note that the state will be approving the screening section of all volunteers once the background checks have been completed and before the county office can approve enrollments. Most volunteers will be considered a Tier 2 volunteer which will consist of a \$15 background check fee completed by a private company. This will be conducted every 3 years.

Some of our volunteers will be considered a Tier 3 volunteer which will consist of a background check along with fingerprinting and will cost around \$55. Volunteers in Tier 3 who work with camp (residential and day camps) or chaperone over night trips with 4-H members will fall under Tier 3.

4-H Camp Update

Many have been waiting to hear some type of update about the 2021 Carroll County 4-H Residential Camp program. At this time, we still do not know what the 2021 camp experience will look like this summer. We hope that we will be able to offer some type of in-person camp experience. In order to be prepared, we will be moving forward with teen leader interviews on **Saturday, March 20, 2021**. Please note that camp interviews will be conducted virtually as the 4-H program remains closed to in-person volunteer led programs.

First week – June 21-24, 2021 Second week – July 12-16, 2021

Beef Field Day

The 2021 Beef Field Day will be held on **Saturday, May 15th at the Howard County Fairgrounds**. We will be partnering with the Howard County 4-H Program to offer educational opportunities and chances to show in showmanship, beef/dairy steer classes and breeding heifers. We are excited for the chance to partner with Howard County, allowing Carroll County 4-H members to show multiple animals this year! Registration information was handed out at weigh-in, but can be found attached to the Tribune. Registration and payment is due to the Carroll County Extension Office by Friday, April 23rd. Registrations can be brought to the beef workshop (if attending) or left in the dropbox at the office. If you have specific questions, please contact a beef committee member or Becky Ridgeway.

Market Swine, Sheep and Goat Weigh-in and Tagging

If you plan to exhibit one of the above animals at the county or state fair, it must have a Maryland 4-H ear tag and be weighed in Carroll County. You must turn in a completed 2-part form to the Extension Office with the number of tags you will need by **April 30th for Swine (Weigh-in Date – Friday, May 7th, 5-9 P.M.)** and **May 7th (Weigh-in date for Lambs and Goats – Friday, May 14th, 5-8 P.M.)**. Remember, to fill in ALL information, including RFID/Scrapie tag numbers. The Animal Science Code of Ethics will be on the reverse side and BOTH pages must be signed. **Tags cost \$2 for swine, lambs and goats**. Checks can be made payable to CCEAC. You must register, tag and weigh-in the appropriate animal for Carroll County. You may not weigh-in your animals at another county and be eligible for the Carroll County 4-H/FFA Fair. Questions? Call 410-386-2760.

More information will be provided closer to weigh-in dates about COVID precautions and how each weigh-in will be handled.

Castration Policy of the Maryland 4-H AnSc Program: All male steers, lambs, pigs and goats must be neutered and healed prior to 4-H weigh-in and tagging. The only exception would be animals that have obvious signs they have been banded, however, their scrotal sac is still intact.

Livestock Registration Forms

Livestock registration forms are a 2-page carbon copy form that cannot be printed from home. We will be working on mailing registration forms to all 4-H members who submitted 2020 project records for swine, sheep and meat goat projects towards the end of March. There will also be a box available outside of the extension office with forms too. If you are a new 4-Her or adding one of the above projects and will need the forms mailed to you, please email Becky at bridgewa@umd.edu with how many forms you will need. Please remember that each species needs to be on their own form.

Poultry Orientation

For ANYONE who plans to or is thinking about showing poultry at the 2021 Carroll County 4-H/FFA Fair, there are several exhibitor meetings scheduled and you are **REQUIRED** to attend "one" of them. **Meeting dates are as follows: Tuesday, May 4th (Extension Office), Thursday, May 13th (Poultry Barn), and Wednesday, June 2nd (Poultry Barn).** All meetings start at 7 P.M. There will also be an **online option for 2021 which you can complete along with a quiz for credit as attending the meeting in person.** Again, you are **REQUIRED** to attend only one in-person meeting or the online video/ quiz. Remember for those 4-Hers who exhibited in 2020, you are required to have turned in a "completed" project record for your poultry project in order to exhibit in 2021. Livestock Weigh-In

Dog Training

Registration and the initial DOG EVALUATION SESSION will take place for Carroll County 4-H Dog Training Classes on **Tuesday, April 6th from 6:30 P.M. - 8 P.M.** at the Carroll County Extension Office. If you have questions, please call Robin Korotki at 410-239-6251 (leave a message, please). Youth and parents need to attend an initial program session. **You will need to provide all registration paperwork at the Evaluation** (paperwork will be emailed to you after you register), including a copy of your dog's rabies certificate and county dog license/tag to be left on file with the trainers, along with your dog. Dogs without a valid rabies certificate or county dog license will NOT be allowed to attend training classes. If the rabies certificate expires during training, you must bring the new certificate with you at the next possible training date. If you think you might be substituting a dog within the training classes, bring those certificates and license/tags with you also. Please take the time to register as many dogs as you think you may need through the training sessions.

Remember, you will need to bring your dog(s) with you on April 6th for the evaluation class. If a dog is deemed to be not suitable for this kind of training, it will be dismissed. A youth may substitute another dog for training, but it must be present on April 6th for the evaluation. The minimum age for dogs participating in this program is at least 6 months of age by April 6th. *There will be no classes for Clover age youth*. This meeting is mandatory!

Fees for this year are:

A \$25 fee is required for all Carroll County 4-H Members. Payment will be accepted at the April 6th Evaluation. The Carroll County 4-H Dog Care and Training Classes are open to Carroll County 4-H members ages 8-18. **The Training classes will be held on Tuesday evenings beginning May 4th** and will run most Tuesdays until the fair. The CC 4-H Dog Show will be held on Sunday, July 25th.

Register for the Dog Training Program—Complete the registration at the link provided. Once your information is received, you will receive an email with all paperwork that must be completed and brought with you to the April 6th Dog Evaluation.

Please know that we will be using a new registration system called ShoWorks, so your registration screen will look different this year. Indoor Building Update—We all thought the 2020 Carroll County Youth Fair was different and as a result things will be different with the indoor departments in 2021. Last year, some 4-Hers and FFA members decided not to exhibit at the Youth Show for various reasons. This year, a 4-H or FFA member can enter project work completed in 2020 or 2021, but only 1 entry per class.

We plan to have club exhibits this year. All departments, except club books, will be able to enter 1 entry per class, entering either work completed in 2020 or 2021. However, there will be classes for program, secretary and treasurer books for 2019 and 2020. Otherwise, there can be 2 program books for a club because they will be in different classes. All club exhibits, except Gingerbread houses will be entered on Thursday, July 29th.

The crafts department will have a new class for gnomes-any medium. A new class that was added last year was painting on rock. This year, there is more direction as what should be done for that class; look for the updates in the craft department rules.

The general department is expanding their Lego classes. This year, there will be 4 classes and hopefully a contest. Watch for more information.
