# AG Happenings

## University of Maryland Extension Virtual Agronomy Meeting

University of Maryland Extension will host a statewide Virtual Agronomy Meeting on February 3, 2022. The meeting will begin at 9am and participants must register at <https://tinyurl.com/2p8m6a23>. Topics will include weed management, fungicide use on corn and soybeans, soil fertility and variety trial data. The meeting will offer complete recertification credits for Maryland and Pennsylvania private pesticide applicators and Maryland nutrient management voucher.

## Private Applicator Test Training

Farmers that apply restricted-use pesticides are required to have Maryland Private Applicators Licenses. The Private Applicator Licenses allow farmers to apply restricted-use pesticides to property that they own or manage for the purposes of farming. To obtain a Private Applicator License, farmers must pass the Private Applicator Maryland exam and apply for the licenses. Training will be held on January 31<sup>st</sup> from 6:30-9:30 pm at the Garrett County Extension Office.
