Direct Sow Zones - This is based on Freeze/Frost Data. Maryland Falls into the May-July time for direct Sow →

Direct Sow

- June-July / jun-jul
- May-July / may-jul
- Apr-Aug / abr-ago
- Mar-Sept / mar-sep

Front of Seed Packet

Name (Common & Latin) → MELON CUCAMELON
Mouse Melon
Melothria scabra

How long before you can eat them → \$2.69
24 seeds
WARM SEASON
90 DAYS
Sow after last chance of spring frost

Heirloom! A variety that is at least 50 yrs old & is open pollinated. → **HEIRLOOM**
Adorable little "watermelons" that taste like cucumbers are fun to grow. Eat fresh, pickle, or use as an olive substitute. Also known as Mexican sour gherkin.

More details about Veggie → Cute, grape-sized fruits look like tiny watermelons with a clean cucumber flavor, often with a hint of tartness. Pickle and add to a martini for a fun visual twist! Also called sandita or Mexican sour gherkin because the fruits turn more sour as they mature. Long vines up to 10' produce plenty of "watermelons" to harvest from summer to fall. A terrific container or hanging basket variety! This packet sows 8 mounds.

When to direct sow vs. starting inside → **When to sow outside:** 1 to 2 weeks after average last frost, and when soil temperature is at least 65°F. **When to start inside:** 4 to 6 weeks before average last frost.
