

2022 Maryland 4-H Horse Bowl Contest

4-H Horse Bowl provides an opportunity for two teams of three to four players to face off in front of a panel of judges and the moderator who asks questions during the matches. Each match consists of One-on-One questions which are limited to one player from each team to answer, and Open questions which may be answered by all players of each team. Players must be quick on the buzzer to earn the chance to answer the questions. Correct answers score points for the team.

The 2022 Horse Bowl Contest will be held over **TWO dates: March 5-6, 2022** and will be conducted using the online platform called QuizBowl Pro in combination with Zoom. The contest will feature Junior, Intermediate, and Senior age divisions. Seniors who compete in the Horse Bowl Contest in March will be invited to a separate Senior Invitational Buzz-Off that will be used to determine the 2022 Maryland 4-H State Horse Bowl Team. The date of the Senior Invitational Buzz-Off and additional details about the Horse Bowl Contest and the Senior Invitational Buzz-Off will be announced soon. Questions are due to Becca at regunder@umd.edu no later than February 4, 2022 and registration for the event will be due by February 11, 2022. 2022 Maryland 4-H Horse Communications Contest

The Maryland 4-H Horse Communications Contest provides an opportunity for youth enrolled in 4-H to demonstrate their public speaking skills and knowledge of equine-related subject matter in a competitive setting where attitudes of friendliness and fairness prevail. For this contest, members will submit a recording of their speech or demonstration for judges to evaluate. Three categories are offered for this contest including: 1) Individual Presentation, 2) Team Presentation, and 3) Individual Public Speech. Awards are offered in three age divisions: 1) Junior (ages 8-10), 2) Intermediate (ages 11-13), and 3) Senior (ages 14-18).

The 2022 Horse Communications Contest will again be held virtually. Registration for the contest will be open from April 4-18th. Members must submit their recorded presentations between those dates. 2022 Maryland 4-H Hippology Contest

The Maryland 4-H Hippology Contest tests the 4Her's intimate knowledge of horses and horse related items. At the junior and intermediate level, there are three parts to the contest: a written exam, identification stations, and judging classes. The senior level has four parts to the contest, as it also includes a set of projected slides in order to match the national program.

The Hippology contest will be completed during the Maryland 4-H Horse Judging Contest on **June 11**, **2022** to be held at the Howard County Fairgrounds. 2022 Maryland 4-H Horse Judging Contest

The Maryland 4-H State Horse Judging Contest tests the 4-Her's knowledge of horse conformation and way of going. The contest has a mixture of halter and under saddle (or in harness) classes with 4 horses to judge in each class. After placing the classes and enjoying a short lunch, contestants are required to defend their placings for classes by giving "oral reasons" to the judges.


