Spring Weigh-In

The weigh-in for all market sheep, swine, and goats will be held on May 13th. Animals will be tagged and weighed. All market swine are required to have a USDA Radio-Frequency Identification (RFID) tag. If you have questions about the RFID tags, please call MDA at (410) 841-5700. MDA Health Forms, also known as Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection (CVI) forms are required for all exhibited animals.

Contact your veterinarian to make arrangements for getting health forms completed for all animals that will be weighed in or shown at the District Show. There will not be a veterinarian doing health checks at weigh-in, you must contact your vet 4 weeks ahead to complete health checks and health papers. Weigh-in weights will be the beginning weight that will be used in the rate of gain calculations. All Garrett County youth participating in the Western Maryland District Show must weigh their animals on Friday evening. Packets were mailed to members with market livestock projects. If you are planning on showing a commercial heifer, lamb, or goat, please contact the office to get a commercial animal registration card. Commercial (not registered) breeding animals are required to be tagged at Spring Weigh-in unless the animal already has a tag from a previous year. Please contact the UME office if you need a card for a commercial breeding animal.

Western Maryland District Show



The District Show is scheduled for May 14, 2022 at the Garrett County Fairgrounds. Entry deadline is May 6, 2022.

Details were included in packets mailed out on March 15th. If you should need assistance with registering, contact the UME office.

Livestock Entries for State Fair

If you are planning to take a market animal to the State Fair, the animal must be tagged at the May 13th weigh-in. Contact the UME Office at 301 334-6960 to obtain your State Fair Animal ID card to bring with your animal to weigh-in. Animals must be registered using the online state fair entry form. The guidelines and the 2022 Online Entry Systems are available at http://www.marylandstatefair.com/exhibitors/4-h. Notice that at the deadline for State Fair entries is earlier this year, the deadline is July 15, 2022.

The Garrett County Public Speaking Contest was held on Thursday, March 17th at the Extension Office. Presentations by the youth, ages 8 to 18, were provided in four categories. Radio Spot, Prepared, Interpretation and Extemporaneous. The Radio Spot speakers provided a 30-second speech to promote 4-H participation. The Prepared speakers prepared a speech of 3-6 minutes on any subject and practiced prior to the event. The Extemporaneous speakers selected a topic at the site, they then had 15-30 minutes to plan and present their speech. The Interpretation speaker provided a presentation that was dramatic and humorous.

The judges for the event were Janet Tichnell and Marvin Beckman.

All 4-H members named as champions are eligible to participate in the State Public Speaking contest that will be held on April 23rd at the Carroll County Extension Office in Westminster, MD.

- · Scarecrow must be between 4-6 feet tall
