There are five separate events: Bicycle, Small Engines, Electricity, Tractor, and Lawn & Garden Tractor. Each of the contests has various components such as driving, parts identification, and visual presentations. You may enter as many of the contests as you like. If you compete in at least three (3) contests, you will qualify for the overall engineering event trophy. The Maryland State Fair hosts the statewide contests. Individuals must enter through the online registration system at <a href="https://www.marylandstatefair.com">www.marylandstatefair.com</a> by July 15th for electric/energy, and small engine events. For bicycle, lawn tractor and tractor event entries are made by the 4-H Educator for the county first place members.

# **Jaryn Teets Headed to Nationals**

The 2022 Maryland 4-H Horse Bowl Contest was held in March using the online platform called QuizBowl Pro in combination with Zoom. Following that contest, senior-level members (ages 14-18) who competed in the Horse Bowl Contest were invited to a separate Senior Invitational Buzz-Off that was to be used to determine the 2022 Maryland 4-H State Horse Bowl Team. Representing Garrett County at the Buzz-Off were Jaryn Teets and Claire Hilton who are both members of the Garrett Hoof Prints 4-H Club.

Jaryn Teets, pictured below, won first place in the Maryland State Horse Bowl Buzz-Off. She will be representing Garrett County in the first chair at the Eastern National 4-H Horse Roundup that will be held this November at the Kentucky Fair & Expo Center in Louisville, Kentucky. Horse Bowl participants study from a variety of resources, such as the Horse Industry Handbook, Horse Smarts, and handbooks from the American Youth Horse Council. Teams began studying and meeting several months prior to the contest. To succeed in Horse Bowl, young people must have a working knowledge of all topics including general equine terms, the horse industry, feeding and care, and anatomy.

## What is Avian Influenza?

Maryland Department of Agriculture has announced that poultry sales and shows in Maryland have been cancelled due to an outbreak of avian influenza. This means that there will not be any poultry exhibits at the Garrett County Fair this year, this also includes egg exhibits.

Avian influenza is an infectious, viral disease of birds. Avian influenza viruses usually do not infect humans but several cases of human infection have been reported so careful handling of birds and handwashing is always a good practice. The virus can be carried by wild birds and then may be transmitted to backyard or farm flocks.

## **Animal Quality Assurance Is Open!**

All 4-H members enrolled in alpacas, beef, dairy, goats, horse and pony, llamas, poultry, sheep, swine and rabbits are required to have completed the on-line training prior to July 1st to be eligible to exhibit their project animals at the 2022 Garrett County Agriculture Fair or the Maryland State Fair.

The 2022 program must be completed using Firefox, Chrome or Safari web browsers. The program is not supported by Internet Explorer. The program contains two levels, a Junior-aged Level and an Intermediate/Senior-aged Level. The program automatically directs members to the correct level based on their birthdate.

4-Hers are required to complete the on-line training program:

- •If this is their first year as a 4-H member
- •When they reach each 4-H age division (juniors (8-10), intermediates (11-13), seniors (14-18) as of January 1 of the current year)
- •When an Intermediate or Senior 4-H member chooses to show a new species since last completing the program within their age division they must return to the program and complete it for the new species area

(The Junior program does not have species specific sections as the Intermediate/Senior program does). Passcodes issued in 2015-2021 should still be viable for returning members. Members with passcodes issued prior to 2015 must register to receive a new passcode. Members may access the AH&QA program at: <a href="https://ahqa.umd.edu/">https://ahqa.umd.edu/</a>. # 4-H State Public Speaking




