On September 24, 2022, members of the Flaming Arrows 4-H Club represented Harford County at the Maryland State 4-H Archery Competition at the Carroll County Agriculture Complex. Each competitor was grouped into 4-H age divisions (junior, intermediate or senior) as well as bow type (compound or recurve) and shot in both a FITA and 3D target shoot. Medals were awarded for the top three placings in the FITA category, 3D target shoot, and overall score. 


### Maryland State 4-H Dog Bowl Registration Portal is now OPEN!
