## NEW ASSOCIATE DEAN AND DIRECTOR OF UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND

The College of Agriculture and Natural Resources has announced the selection of Dr. Jinhee Kim as the new Associate Dean and associate director of University of Maryland Extension (UME). Her appointment will begin on October 10, 2022, following the retirement of Dr. Jim Hanson.

Dr. Kim's roots with UME run deep. She joined the University of Maryland in 2000 as an assistant professor and family finance Extension specialist within the School of Public Health and has advanced her career over two-plus decades serving as professor and assistant director/program leader for UME's Family and



Consumer Sciences (FCS) program. Working in tandem with her talented faculty and staff, Kim has significantly increased FCS visibility across the state, securing multi-million dollar funding

for new initiatives and programming related to rural mental and behavioral health, vaccine hesitancy, and digital literacy, to name a few.



### SUBMIT YOUR SOIL AND MANURE SAMPLES FOR 2023

As a reminder to our farmers, fall is a great time to take soil samples for your 2023 nutrient management plan after crops are harvested.

We have a box in our office foyer to place soil and manure samples in for our staff to process. When leaving samples in the box, please label the samples with your name, address, phone number, field number and crop to be planted.




We will invoice the producer for the cost of the sample and shipping. Soil samples are \$12.00 per sample plus \$5.00 shipping. And, manure samples are \$50.00. A manure sample is needed every year for farms that are spreading manure in their fields.

### PRIVATE PESTICIDE APPLICATORS LICENSE CLASS TO BE OFFERED

If you are interested in obtaining a private pesticide applicators license, we will be offering training in January at the UME- Garrett County Office. A date will be publicized once available.

The main purpose of the private pesticide applicators license is to allow farmers to use restricted-use pesticides on property they own or manage for agriculture production. To obtain the license, farmers must pass a test administered by Maryland Department of Agriculture.
