Thank you for participating in the Backyard Buffers program. The following trees species information and photos are from the Missouri Botanical Garden. All species are Maryland natives









Buttonbush- Cephalanthus occidentalis


Can tolerate shallow standing water. Pollinator friendly. Average Size: 3-8 ft tall Sun: Full Sun to part shade Water: Medium to wet soil moisture

Persimmon- Diospyros virginiana

Produces fruit that is a valued wildlife food. Pollinator friendly. Average Size: 35-60 ft tall and wide Sun: Full Sun to part shade Water: Dry to medium soil moisture

Swamp White oak- Quercus bicolor

Planted for wildlife food and cover. Average Size: 50-80 ft tall Sun: Full sun Water: Medium to wet soil moisture



Sycamore- Platanus occidentalis

Large tree for a large space. Pollinator friendly

Average Size: Grows up to 120 feet Sun: Full Sun Water: Medium to wet soil moisture
