Try Something New!

Don't forget your feathered friends this winter! Here is an easy recipe for birdseed cookies!

1 1/4 cups of birdseed

1 packet of unflavored gelatin

1 tablespoon of corn syrup

1/4 cup boiling water and 1/4 cup cold water

parchment paper and baking sheet

cookie cutters or mason jar lids

drinking straw

twine for hanging

**Please note this activity requires the addition of boiling water. Please ask an adult for permission and assistance before making birdseed cookies!

Step 1: In a large bowl, sprinkle the unflavored gelatin over the cold water. Next, carefully add the boiling water and stir until it is completely dissolved.

Step 2: Next add your corn syrup and stir. Once all of your wet ingredients are incorporated, add the birdseed and stir until the seed is coated. Place in the refrigerator for 10-15 minutes.

Step 3: Line your baking sheet with parchment paper. Lay your cookie cutters or jar lids on top of the parchment and fill will the bird seed mixture. Press well to ensure no gaps are present. Cut your drinking straw into 2 inch pieces and add to the center of each mold for the twine. Place in the refrigerator for 8 hours or overnight.

Step 4: Press the birdseed cookies out of the molds. Add twine and hang outside for the birds to enjoy!

She loved working on her county projects, leading as Maryland 4-H State Council President, and attending national leadership trips. This last November, Lindsey was invited to attend the first ever National 4-H Congress Design Team Reunion, where she met with design team members from past years.
