We are pleased to present our 2022 Annual Snapshot of UME Programs designed to address critical issues in Garrett County and beyond. Our wide range of educational efforts help






#### Maryland SNAP-Ed in Garrett County!

We focus on good nutrition, stretching food dollars, living physically active lifestyles and engaging partners to build a healthier community. SNAP-Ed stands for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program - Education

#### Focus on Fruits and Vegetables!

- · 190 fruit and veggie food tastings across Garrett County
- 430 Garrett County students reached with multiple nutrition lessons
- 1078 parents reached with recipes and food related information
- 880+ books distributed Sylvia's Spinach, by Katherine Pryor to help picky eaters maybe be a little less picky!
- 880+ Grow Kits provided to grow sugar snap peas in classrooms then to take home to plant and eat!





#### Fitness = Fun!

- · Indoor and outdoor recess supplies provided to Broad Ford, Crellin, Friendsville and
- · Grantsville elementary schools
- 82 teachers provided with training to increase physical activity during the school day especially during inclement weather
- 400 Water bottles distributed to quench that thirst for students and teachers
- Gardening programs and/or summer school sessions supported with SNAP-Ed funding, nutrition education and tastings at Crellin, Friendsville and Grantsville elementary schools

The garden in a glove activity was fantastic for helping me and my daughter learn to garden. We are trying! We planted each of the five sprouts in a garden tub and watched them grow...or not grow. Some were successful and some weren't. The green beans and the squash are doing amazing! It has been so much fun for both of us to watch and learn. - Garrett Neighbors program was created by Community Action to help foster a stronger sense of community in senior HUD-Low Income Housing Centers.
  - 3 activities with a total of 125 participants
- Appalachian Crossroads is an organization that empowers individuals with disabilities to contribute
  to our community's tapestry. Through the community living, employment support, and day services
  we offer, they may choose lives rich with meaning, friendship, and inclusivity.
  - Prepared and conducted with Master Gardener support-7 gardening activity sessions for 15 people each session. March-June 2022

#### **Master Gardener Impacts**

- More than 500 contacts made in Garrett County by Master Gardeners at booths, festivals, and school allowing more people to learn about home horticulture; thus, increasing the possibility of residents growing their own fruits and vegetables and decreasing food insecurity.
- Master Gardeners recorded 115 hours of continuing education hours to ensure that the latest and greatest information is being shared at public events.
- Garrett County Master Gardeners logged 266 hours of volunteer service worth \$7,966. (\$29.95 per hour Independent Sector stats).

The Master Gardeners always have a terrific educational display which is well-received by visitors!
