If you compete in at least three (3) contests, you will qualify for the overall engineering event trophy. The Maryland State Fair hosts the statewide contests. Individuals must enter through the online registration system at www.marylandstatefair.com by July 15th for electric/energy, and small engine events. For bicycle, lawn tractor and tractor event entries are made by the 4-H Educator for the county first place members.

Animal Quality Assurance Is Open!



All 4-H members enrolled in alpacas, beef, dairy, goats, horse and pony, llamas, poultry, sheep, swine and rabbits are required to have completed the on-line training prior to July 1st to be eligible to exhibit their project animals at the 2023 Garrett County Agriculture Fair or the Maryland State Fair. The 2023 program must be completed using Firefox, Chrome or Safari web browsers. The program is not supported by Internet Explorer. The program contains two levels, a Junior-aged Level and an Intermediate/Senior-aged Level. The program automatically directs members to the correct level based on their birthdate.

4-Hers are required to complete the on-line training program:

- If this is their first year as a 4-H member
- When they reach each 4-H age division (juniors (8-10), intermediates (11-13), seniors (14-18) – as of January 1 of the current year)
- When an Intermediate or Senior 4-H member chooses to show a new species since last completing the program within their age division - they must return to the program and complete it for the new species area (The Junior program does not have species specific sections as the Intermediate/Senior program does). Passcodes issued in 2018-2023 should still be viable for returning members. Members with passcodes issued prior to 2015 must register to receive a new passcode. With an increased potential of disease transmissions occurring when large numbers of animals gather for exhibition, MDA has set forth requirements for exhibitors to follow at Maryland fairs and shows. 4-H STEM in the Classroom

This year 4-H was able to provide STEM in the classroom to Swan Meadow School's middle school students. Karen Wood, Garrett County 4-H STEM Educator and Hannah Frazee, 4-H AmeriCorps Volunteer brought fun and entertaining programs monthly to the middle school students. The youth participated in the following activities this year:

- *4-H STEM Challenge achieving neutral buoyancy of a submarine submerged
- *Circuitry to learn about electricity making a simple and parallel circuit
- *Snow Globe Science with a lesson on viscosity and pine identification
- *Reverse Painting using critical thinking skills using layers in reverse
- *Earthquake Challenge with a lesson on geography and an engineering challenge
- *Edison Robots where students created their own challenges using concepts of obstacle detection and artificial intelligence
- *3D Design with a lesson the on the invasive pest Spotted Lanternfly.
