Rachel was also the Assistant Superintendent of the Rabbit Barn at the Fair and kept the show order and recorded who got what place. She leaves behind two sons, Jeremy and Maddox Gordon; fiancé Elmer Gordon; parents, John and Darlene Schmidt; Sister Pam Ketterman and brother in law Gary and their daughter Bristal.

In other Club news, Jeremy Gordon and Bristal Ketterman went to the Maryland State Fair to show rabbits. Jeremy got a first with his mini rex and third with his Polish. Bristal Showed one of Maddox Gordons rabbits, who also went, but couldn't show yet and won 3rd in Best of Breed. Bristal showed two jersey woolies, one got first, Best of Variety and Best of Breed.
