# **Livestock News & Updates**

## **Animal Husbandry & Quality Assurance**

All 4-H/FFA members exhibiting animals are required to complete the AHQA online training program once for each age division (as of January 1 of the current year): Juniors (ages 8-10); Intermediates (ages 11-13); Seniors and FFA members (ages 14-18). OR when as Intermediate and Senior 4-H members, they choose to show a new species since last completing the program within their age division.

Quality Assurance must be completed by July 1, 2024, to show any animals at the 2024 Allegany County Fair. The system is now open. Go to <a href="https://ahqa.umd.edu/">https://ahqa.umd.edu/</a>.

#### **IMPORTANT LIVESTOCK FAIR UPDATES**

#### New Ag Expo Rule - Barn Setup and Cleanup:

"All livestock exhibitors are expected to participate in setup and cleanup of the livestock barn. Dates and times will be provided. Any livestock exhibitor who fails to participate in such will forfeit up to forty percent (40%) of their livestock sales proceeds to the Allegany County Ag Expo, Inc. Any exhibitor who requests a waiver or exception must do so in writing at least thirty (30) days before livestock move-in, and the decision of such shall be in the sole discretion of the Board of Directors of the Allegany County Ag Expo, Inc."

#### **Market Chickens:**

- All market chickens (carcasses) must weigh at least 5 pounds each. Any carcass under that weight will not be judged or sold.
- Wednesday, July 10 between 8 and 9 a.m. Take market chickens to Smith's to be processed.

To save time during exhibit entry, please pre-register. Pre-entry forms are due by **July 10, 2024.** 4-H families may drop them off at our office or email them to jparrish@umd.edu. If after hours, you may put them in our locked mail box.



#### **BOOTHS AND BANNERS**

Each club may enter <u>one</u> booth and <u>one</u> banner. You may enter in either open-theme or annual-theme, which is "**Find Your Spark in 4-H.**" Please be sure to submit an indoor entry form in the club's name <u>and</u> call the 4-H office to reserve space. #### FAIR BADGES AND PARKING PASSES



Fair badges will only be given to registered 4-H members exhibiting livestock, siblings of the exhibitors (under age 18), 4-H volunteers, and parents/guardians of the exhibitors. Club leaders will be contacted to collect the list of names for their club. If you are not affiliated with a livestock club, email jparrish@umd.edu for passes.

Parking passes - Each 4-H family with livestock exhibitors will receive 2 parking passes. When badges and passes are available, an announcement will be made.


The 2024 Allegany County Fair Book is now available online.
