

#### MARKET CHICKENS

Exhibitors must complete a special carcass show form for their market pen of two birds and drop it off with the market birds at Smiths Custom Meats in Hyndman PA on

Wednesday, July 10 between 8 and 9 a.m.
All market chickens (carcasses) must weigh at least 5 pounds each. Any carcass under that weight will not be judged or sold. Results will be shared during the Breeding Poultry Show.

Smiths will bring the carcasses vacuumed sealed and frozen to the Livestock Sale Saturday morning. Please tell potential buyers to bring a cooler with them that day.

#### 4-H/FFA Show & Sale Attire

#### Rules:

- 1. No farm names or other identification shall appear on show uniforms.
- Hats shall **NOT** be worn in the show ring **OR** during the sale.
- 3. Safe, appropriate attire, including footwear is required at all times. Jewelry does not qualify as a neckpiece due to safety reasons.
- 4. The following show attire is required for all shows and the livestock sale.

#### 4-H

- Beef Cattle, Sheep, Swine, Meat Goats, Rabbits, and Poultry:
  - Tan, green, or black slacks/skirt; white or tan collared shirt, with green or black tie.
- Dairy Goats and Dairy Cattle:
   White slacks/skirt, white collared shirt with green, or black tie.
- Horses:
  - Appropriate riding clothes and head gear.

#### FFA:

- An official FFA jacket zipped to the top.
- Black slacks and black socks/nylons or black skirt and black nylons
- White collared blouse or white collared shirt with official FFA tie or FFA scarf.
- Black dress shoes with closed heel and toe.

#### **NEW 4-H FISCAL YEAR BEGINS JULY 1**

Don't forget that you need to close out your Treasurer Book for July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024.

990 Filing (ePostcard) - Clubs are required to file for July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024 on or before **September 15, 2024**. Clubs can start filing as soon as July 1, 2024. The filing for most clubs is done by the 4-H Office. If you are unsure if you need to file, email jparrish@umd.edu.

Club Financial Packets due **October 1**. The following items for July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024 are due to our office: Treasure Book, Club Annual Financial Summary Report, Club Inventory Report, and Proof of 990 filing.
