

4-H BEEF TAGGING & WEIGH-IN November 23, 2024

8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.





Commercial breeding beef for the 2025 4-H program year must attend this tagging **or** the 2025 spring tagging to receive a 4-H breeding tag. Registered beef females who are tattooed with matching registration breed papers in the name of the 4-H member do not need tagged.

All livestock registration forms are available at https://go.umd.edu/AC-forms. You may also call 301-724-3320 or email jparrish@umd.edu.

Livestock Registration, County Bred, and Bred & Owned forms will be accepted the day of tagging but must be turned in to the 4-H office by **December 1, 2024. No Exceptions**. All forms must include the RFID tag number for each animal.

Wormer and the Triangle 10 HB Cattle Vaccine will be available that day. If you want these options, email jparrish@umd.edu or call 301-724-3320 by November 8. Only those pre-registered for the wormer/vaccine will receive it.

Allegany 4-H Winter Beef Weigh-in Procedure:

November 23, 2024, 8:00-10:00 a.m. (If no one is in line at 10:00 a.m., weigh-in WILL CLOSE.)

- Please bring your completed livestock registration form, except for the tag number and beginning weight, and your County Bred/Bred & Owned forms, if applicable.
- Take your animal to the head gate to be tagged.
 - o Tell them your name.
 - o Let the volunteer know if you registered for the vaccine and/or wormer.
 - o You will receive an index card with your name, your animal's tag number, and weight.
- Return your animal to the trailer.
- Use the information on your index card to complete the livestock registration form.
- Give your completed livestock registration form to the 4-H staff member onsite and any County Bred/Bred & Owned Entry Cards you may have. If you don't turn them in at weigh-in, they must be taken to the 4-H Office **by December 1** no exceptions.
- You will receive a stamped copy of your registration form in the mail within 7 to 10 days for your records.

NOTES:

- All market steers must be tagged at this weigh-in. They must also be castrated and able to be handled properly.
- Commercial beef breeding must be tagged at this weigh-in **or** the Spring weigh-in with a 4-H beef breeding tag. *Forms due December 1 if tagged at this weigh-in.
- Breeding beef registered with a breed association with a matching tattoo in the member's name does not need to be tagged with a 4-H tag. However, a livestock registration form must be completed and submitted with the breed association paper to the 4-H Office.

ALL MARKET AND BREEDING animals must be registered on the 4-H Livestock Registration Form and turned in by the deadline. Market steer livestock registration forms, County Bred and/or Bred and Owned entry forms, and *breeding beef are due **December 1**. Other breeding beef forms are due by **May 1**.

A member may tag any number of <u>market</u> animals of each type. Members are given two tags; they must purchase any additional tags for \$1.00 per tag.

A member may tag any number of <u>breeding</u> animals of each type. Members must purchase 4-H tags at \$1.00 per tag.

- The Triangle 10 HB Cattle Vaccine for vaccination against IBR, BVD Types I and II, PI3, BRSV, and five strains of Leptospirosis.

As per MDA regulation, all beef cattle attending fairs and shows must have an RFID tag for exhibition. RFID tags must be in the animal's ear and recorded on the registration form before the deadline. For more information on RFID tags, visit


2024 National 4-H Conference
