

#### 2026 4-H Enrollment

Families may enroll with Maryland 4-H Online beginning in January 2026. Watch for an email announcement for the opening date.



To enroll in Maryland 4-H Online, you need to use Firefox, Chrome, or Safari web browsers. Go to https://v2.4honline.com/#/user/sign-in

- Current Members Enrollments are due by February 1, 2026.
- New Livestock Members Enrollments are due by April 1, 2026, to show animals at the fair.
- New Members Enrollments are due by June 1, 2026, to be eligible to participate in the county and state fairs.
- Volunteers Enrollments for returning volunteers must be completed by March 1.

It is essential to enroll as soon as possible to continue receiving the newsletter, email updates, and other important announcements.

To remind you, projects and volunteer types & roles will not roll over into next year, so you will need to select your projects and volunteer information again. Volunteers, please verify your volunteer type for 2025 so you know which option to choose. If you are unsure, please call 301-724-3320 or email jparrish@umd.edu.

If you experience any issues with re-enrollment, please contact our office. Please don't create a new family profile.

Enrollment fee - Maryland 4-H has an annual \$10.00 enrollment fee per 4-H member (No fee is collected for volunteers and any children in a family with more than three children). Families will pay the enrollment fee online by credit card at the time they enroll.

#### Gift Idea - Hot Chocolate in a Jar

#### **Ingredients**

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- ½ cup powdered milk
- ½ cup chocolate chips
- 1-1½ cup mini marshmallows

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Layer the dry ingredients into the jars.
- For a 16-oz mason jar hot chocolate recipe, layer 1 cup of sugar, 1 cup of unsweetened cocoa powder, and 1/2 cup of powdered milk. 1/2 cup chocolate chips, and 1 to 1 1/2 cups mini marshmallows.
- To make two 8-ounce jelly jars, add 1/2 cup of sugar, 1/2 cup of cocoa powder, 1/4 cup of powdered milk, 1/4 cup of chocolate chips, and 1/2 cup of mini marshmallows to each jar. I used a mason jar funnel to make it easy and prevent spilling. Add a lid.
- 2. Create and cut out the tags. Punch a hole in the top left corner of the tag. Include these instructions on the tag: Add 1/4 cup to a mug. Add 8 ounces of hot milk or water and stir.
- 3. Cut twine or ribbon about three feet long. Wrap it around the rim of the jar several times. Stick one end of the twine through the hole in the tag and tie it into a bow.

## 4-H Record Books Due February 1

It is never too early to start wrapping up your 2025 record book. 4-H record books for 2025 are due at the 4-H office by February 1, 2025. Diamond Clover Levels 1 to 4 are also due at this time.

• To meet fair eligibility to show livestock, members must submit a complete record book with a completed project sheet for each project exhibited at the 2025 Allegany County Fair to show at the 2026 Allegany County Fair.

For a complete guide and forms, go to https://go.umd.edu/AC-forms. It is recommended that you use a 3-ring binder or 3-prong folder for your record book. Traditional 4-H record book covers are available at the office for \$3.50 each; however, they are not required.
