Class Descriptions

Rabbit Breeding ~ Kim Cayton

This class will address the basics in rabbit breeding, including environment, proper techniques, and rabbit health. We will also address problems that you may encounter during rabbit breeding.

Raising Meat Rabbits ~ Jim House

This class will show how to raise a quality meat rabbits that will be able to compete in the "Pen of Three" category at the Garrett County Fair.

Showmanship ~ Rachel Schmidt

This class will teach youth how to show a rabbit and compete in a showmanship contest.

Wendy Feaga Video ~ Rabbit DQ's

This 10 minute video will be shown about rabbit disqualifications and a group discussion will follow.

Color Coat Genetics ~ Kim Cayton

Participants will learn about the main color coat combinations that are involved in breeding a rabbit.

Rabbit Diseases ~ Jennifer Bernard

This class will discuss the various diseases that a rabbit can get. We will go over how to treat simple ailments and prevent the rabbit from getting diseases.
