## 4-H Animal Projects at the Maryland State Fair

### General Information

The Maryland State Fair provides opportunities for 4-H members to showcase their project work to fair guests from all across Maryland and surrounding states. More than one-half million guests visit the fair each year.

Fondly known as the “11 Best Days of Summer”, the State Fair is held during the last week of August through Labor Day. The State Fairgrounds is located in Timonium just west of Baltimore and has been at this location for more than 125 years.

The 4-H program holds many events and activities during the annual fair. Animal Science events and activities include animal shows for alpacas, beef, dairy, dogs, goats, horses, poultry, rabbits, sheep and swine. We are also fortunate to hold Judging Contests for program areas including dairy, goats, poultry, livestock, and rabbits at the Maryland State Fair.
