## Carroll County Farm Bureau 2013 Scholarship Application Deadline May 1, 2013

The Carroll County Farm Bureau will offer **FIVE** \$1,000.00 scholarships. Applicants must be high school seniors starting college in the fall of 2013 or full time college students at any community college, technical school or four-year institution. Three of the scholarships will be offered to agriculture curriculum majors and two scholarships will be offered to either non agricultural or agricultural curriculum majors. Selection will be made by a committee designated by the Carroll County Farm Bureau Board of Directors. The selection committee will evaluate each Application anonymously. No student can receive this scholarship more than four times.

## **Application Criteria:**

- 1. Applicants or their parents/guardians **MUST** be members in good standing with Carroll County Farm Bureau.
- 2. Submit Completed Application Form
- 3. Provide a Current Transcript
- 4. Provide a Resume including Community Service Projects Hours an after school extracurricular activities
- 5. Submit a Written Essay

(If ONE or more of the above listed Criteria is NOT met the Application will be disqualified)

## **Essay Question:**

Over the past several years Maryland Agriculture has seen an increase in the use of Niche Marketing and Agriculture Tourism on the family farm. "What benefits can be seen through the use of Niche Marketing and Agritourism on the family farm and in the Maryland Agriculture Industry as a whole?"

The essay should not exceed two pages using 12 point font size, Times New Roman, Double Spaced, with 1 inch margins.

The Carroll County Farm Bureau office <u>MUST</u> receive applications by May 1, 2013. Scholarships will be awarded to winning applicants prior to the beginning of the fall semester. Winners will also be recognized at the Miss Carroll County Farm Bureau Contest at the Carroll County 4-H and FFA fair. The winner's scholarship check will be made out to the student and the college. The committee reserves the right to interview scholarship applicants if they feel it necessary to determine the winners.
