Amelia Grace Dashiell 4-H Horse Scholarship Application



The Purpose of this Scholarship is to encourage and financially aid qualified students who wish to pursue careers in the equine or animal related fields.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:

• One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded annually.

ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS:

- The scholarships are available to any graduating high school seniors who are current 4-H members or 4-H Alumni who are enrolled in a two (2) or four (4) year equine studies, animal science, pre-veterinarian, biology, or zoology program. Preference will be given to applicants pursuing an equine related field.
- Applicants must have carried the 4-H Horse project for a minimum of two years.
- The applicant must have at least a cumulative 2.5 GPA (4.0 scale). The most recent copy of your official academic transcripts from high school or the accredited college, university, or post high school vocational program in which they enrolled prior to should accompany your application package. Awards will not be made without a copy of the official academic transcript.
- All information must be typed or printed on the application form.

- Each applicant may apply for a scholarship for each year of their continuing education although they are only eligible to be awarded an Amelia Grace Dashiell 4-H Horse scholarship twice.
- Two letters of recommendation must accompany each application.

Winner will be notified by August 30th and will be awarded at the Maryland 4-H Horsemen's Party. Recipient must submit their most recent grade transcript and proof of enrollment.
