CARROLL COUNTY 4-H LIVESTOCK CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Currently a 4-H or FFA member in Carroll County;
- 2. Be a graduating senior or high school graduate;
- 3. Be accepted at or already attending college or post secondary school
- 4. Must have shown or exhibited livestock in the Carroll County Program;
- 5. Applicant must have completed units for the previous year's livestock projects <u>and</u> must submit completed units with the scholarship application.

Selection will be based on:

- 1. 4-H/FFA accomplishments, 4-H/FFA participation, financial need and high school/college grades.
- 2. Applicant must furnish a transcript of high school as well as college grades if college courses have been taken.
- **3.** Two letters of recommendation; one from a high school teacher/college professor and one from a 4-H leader or educator. **Use attached form.**
- 4. Decision of the selection committee will be final.
- 5. All candidates must be interviewed.
- 6. Selection committee may decide not to award a scholarship if there are no worthy applicants.

The amount of the scholarship is \$500.00 and the scholarship will only be awarded once to each individual. However, if extra money is available winners may be eligible for a second scholarship based on service to the 4-H program during the following year. See the Livestock Club leader for details and eligibility.

Scholarships will be announced at the 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale at the Carroll County Fair.

Completed application, letters of reference and grade transcripts are due to the Carroll County 4-H Office by June 15. Applicants will be notified of the interview schedule.
