The *Nathan A. Blizzard Memorial 4-H/FFA Scholarship Fund* was established in 1998 by his parents, Melvin Blizzard, Jr. and Dianne Blizzard in honor and memory of their only child. Nathan graduated from South Carroll High School in 1995. He was very active in 4-H and FFA. Nathan was very concerned about the future of dairy farming in Carroll County. He was working to ensure that farmland was preserved for that purpose, so future generations could experience life on the land.

The *Nathan A. Blizzard Memorial 4-H/FFA Scholarship* is a one-time scholarship awarded to a graduating senior or high school graduate who is active in 4-H or FFA in Carroll County. In 2002, three such scholarships were awarded during the annual Carroll County 4-H Fair. Nathan's scholarship is already

perpetuating Carroll County's proud farming tradition.

For most people it takes a long lifetime to make a mark on the world. Nathan had only twenty years, but in that short time, he became a champion for the underdog. No child was abused, ostracized, or left out when Nathan was around. No child was left on the sidelines of a game; he chose them for his team.
