a	Continental dual purpose breed with Maine Tainer Program for registering hybrids
b	Homozygous recessive for red gene; same characteristics as dominant color type cattle
c	Noted for good disposition and milking abilities; can be red, white, or roan
d	Exceptionally long from hooks to pins; French dual purpose breed
e	Originally a Swiss breed, US focuses on "Profit Through Science", good growth rate
f	Developed in US by selecting cattle with the "polled" gene mutation, hardy breed
g	"Tender Beef in a Distinctive Package"; Austrian breed, horned or polled
h	From Lasater Ranch in TX; Brahman x Hereford x Shorthorn
i	Developed in Florida; 3/8 Brahman 5/8 Hereford
j	Old German breed; US registry recognizes hybrid seedstock as Balancer cattle
Sheep Breed Descriptions	
k	Originally a Cotswold x Hampshire cross; large framed breed
l	English breed with bell shape ears; grow rapidly & produce high quality carcasses
m	Used as a terminal sire for commercial lamb production with good milking ability
n	Moderately prolific, longwool dual purpose in high demand from hand spinners
o	Medium size English breed, shown slickshorn in US; Southdown x Leicester xCotswold
p	Dual purpose Australian/New Zealand breed; produce bulky high yielding fleeces
q	Russian breed; early maturing &prolific used commercially due to high performance
r	Polycerate English breed with white and black spotted fleece
s	English meat breed, 1 st assoc. to adopt non-carrier policy for Ectodermal Dysplasia
t	Developed in Dubois, ID by crossing Rambouillet x Lincoln x Corriedale; range sheep
Swine Breed Descriptions	
u	"Thin Rind Breed", terminal sire; associated with Rendement Napole gene
v	Belgian breed with extreme muscling but often carries the halothane gene for PSS
w	Poland China & Gloucester genetics used in this IN breed; fast gaining/feed efficient
x	Rugged, heavy bone Ohio breed that requires six white points for breed registry
y	Designated "America's Sowherd"; prolific & known for length of body
z	English breed; large litters, excellent milker, & good grazer for outside production
aa	Developed by crossing NY & NJ pigs, terminal sire noted for lean grain efficiency
bb	Superior pork quality, popular in Japan as "Kurbota" & other niche marketing in US
cc	Named after a PA county; known for mothering ability, durability, and soundness
dd	"The Mother Breed & a Whole Lot More" is the most recorded breed of swine in US
Goat Breed Descriptions	
ee	Nigerian dwarf breed, heavily muscled and short legs
ff	Name is native word for meat in New Zealand, known for hardiness
gg	These "Brush goats" vary in body shape & color; brought to U.S. by DeSoto
hh	Known for carcass qualities; its breed name is the Dutch word "farmer"
ii	Noted for production of Mohair with grows 1 inch per month
jj	This is a type, not a breed; produces valuable fiber that is light weight & soft
kk	"All Purpose" breed developed in England; strong convex muzzle
