TRAINING TIMES:

All participants should arrive by 7:45 am

• The program will start promptly at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 4, 2023 and will run until approximately 8:00 p.m. that same day. Please plan your travel to

allow for traffic so that you can arrive on time.

ELIGIBILITY:

Participants must be be a UME 4-H Certified Volunteer. This training will be capped at 20 people with registrations taken on a first come first serve basis. Once we have reached 20 people we will start a waiting list and contact you should a spot open up. County Educators will have first level approval for volunteers attending from their county. Following approval, participants will be sent a confirmation email confirming their spot at the training.

REQUIRED PRE WORK

Part of the required training is to complete 4-5 hours of Online pre work prior to the start of the training. This training will be sent following your approval and confirmation email. This is a mandatory requirement for the training. Individuals who are unable to complete this prior to start of in-person training will forfeit their spot and asked to attend a future training.

ACCOMMODATION:

Participants that need special assistance/exception for participation in this training may request accommodation. Indicate the requested accommodation when registering for the event in 4-H Online.

EQUIPMENT:

Each participant should bring outdoor clothing to cope with rain or cool weather. All equipment needed for each discipline will be furnished. Participants are asked not to bring any personal shooting sports equipment to the workshop.

CERTIFICATIONS:

A PARTICIPANT MUST ATTEND THE ENTIRE TRAINING TO BECOME CERTIFIED. Please remember that this is a Certification program. The State 4-H Shooting Sports Committee reserves the right to withhold certification. In addition to a written assessment, each participant will have an opportunity to demonstrate teaching skills as a part of the training program. Participants who successfully complete the training will receive their certification card and instructor number at the end of the training day.



REGISTRATION & FEES:

All participants must register for this event **via 4-H Online. Registration closes at 11:59 pm on February 24, 2023.** An entry fee of **\$100.00** per participant will be charged. The entry fee is payable by credit card through 4-H Online or may be paid by the county/city 4-H program. Local 4-H programs should inform participants on what payment method to choose when registering.

From the North:

(Directions given from Hanover, PA to the Ag Center) Take Rt. 94 South (becomes MD Rt. 30 at the state line). Follow 30 to Manchester and turn right on Rt. 27. Follow Rt. 27 to Rt. 140 East (in Westminster). Turn left onto the ramp to 140 East and travel to the first traffic light. Turn right onto Center Street. Take Center Street through two traffic lights to Gist Road. Turn right on Gist Road and follow signs to the new entrance. Turn right onto the new Ag Center drive.

From the South:

Take Interstate 270 North to Rt. 27. Follow Rt. 27 to Kate Wagner Road. (Kate Wagner Road intersects Rt. 27 before you reach the city of Westminster) Make a right onto Kate Wagner Road (which intersects Rt. 27 at a traffic light) and follow approximately 1.2 miles. Turn left onto Gist Road. Continue on Gist Road until you reach Smith Ave at the stop sign. Continue on Gist Road about 1/2 block and make left at new Ag Center entrance,

From the East:

From Baltimore Beltway 695, take Interstate 795 north toward Westminster. Follow the signs onto MD 140 and take 140 into Westminster. Turn left onto Center Street. Take Center Street through two traffic lights to Gist Road. Turn right on Gist Road and follow signs to the new entrance, turn right onto the new Ag Center drive.

From the West:

Take I-70 East to Mt. Airy/Route 27 Exit. Head North on Rt. 27 toward Westminster for approximately 15 miles. Make a right onto Kate Wagner Road (which intersects Rt. 27 at a traffic light) and follow approximately 1.2 miles. Turn left onto Gist Road. Continue on Gist Road until you reach Smith Ave at the stop sign. Continue on Gist Road about 1/2 block and make a left at the new Ag Center entrance.
